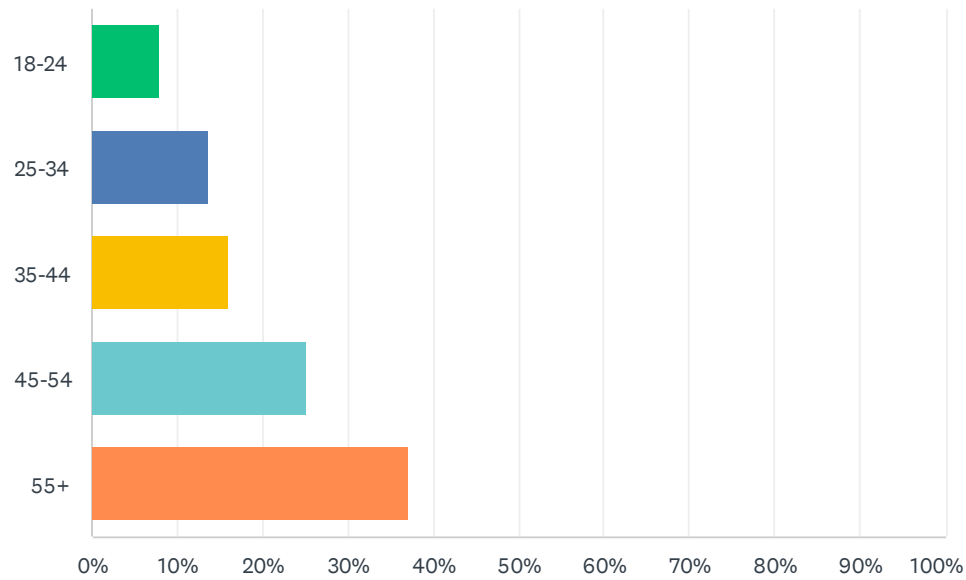


Q1 What is your age?

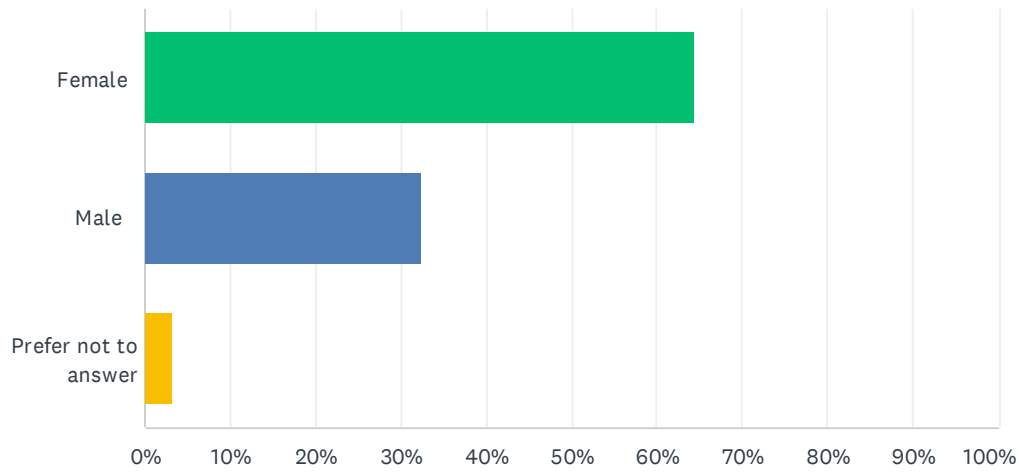

Q2 What is your sex?

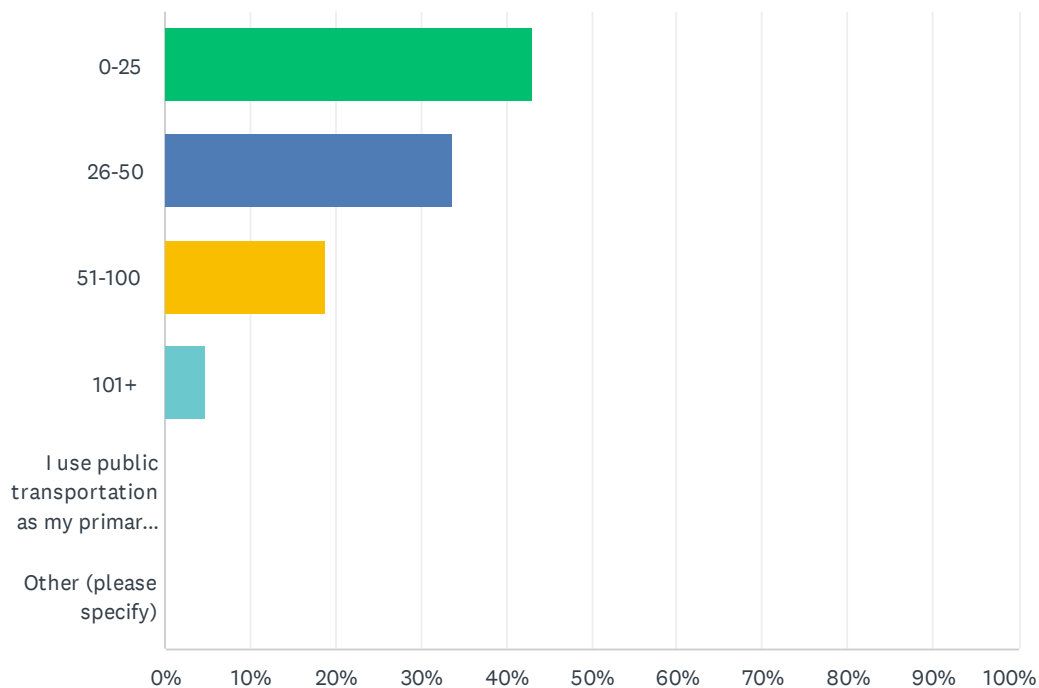

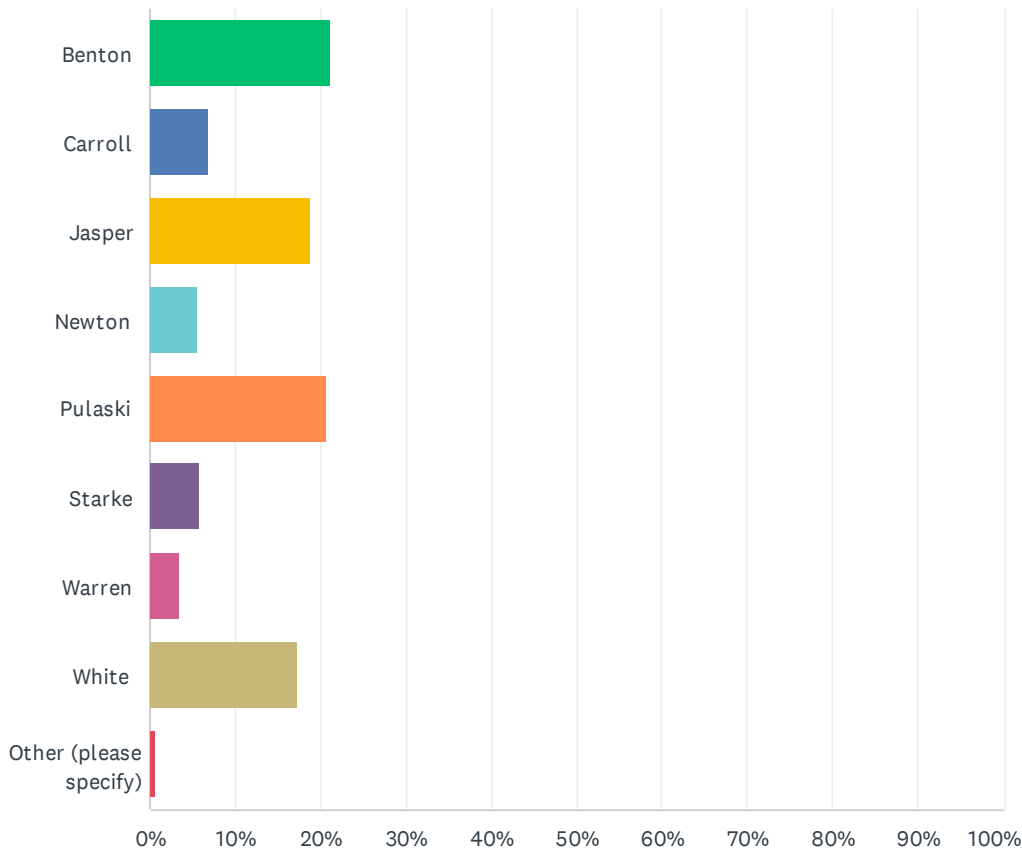

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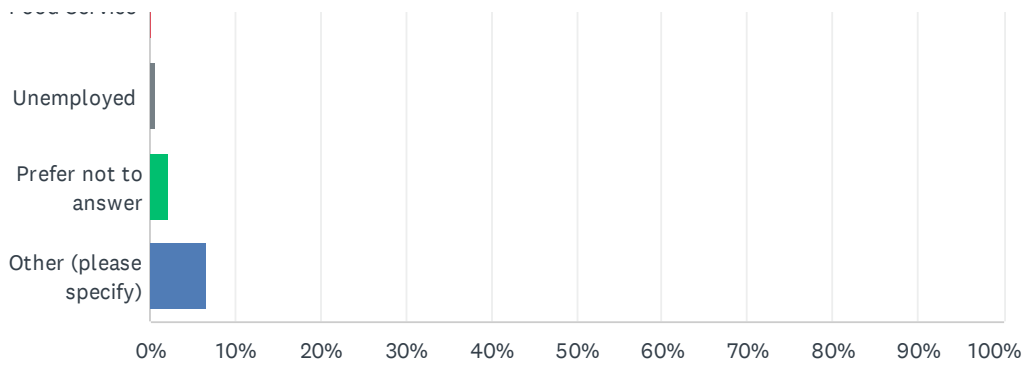

Q7 What is your primary mode of transportation?

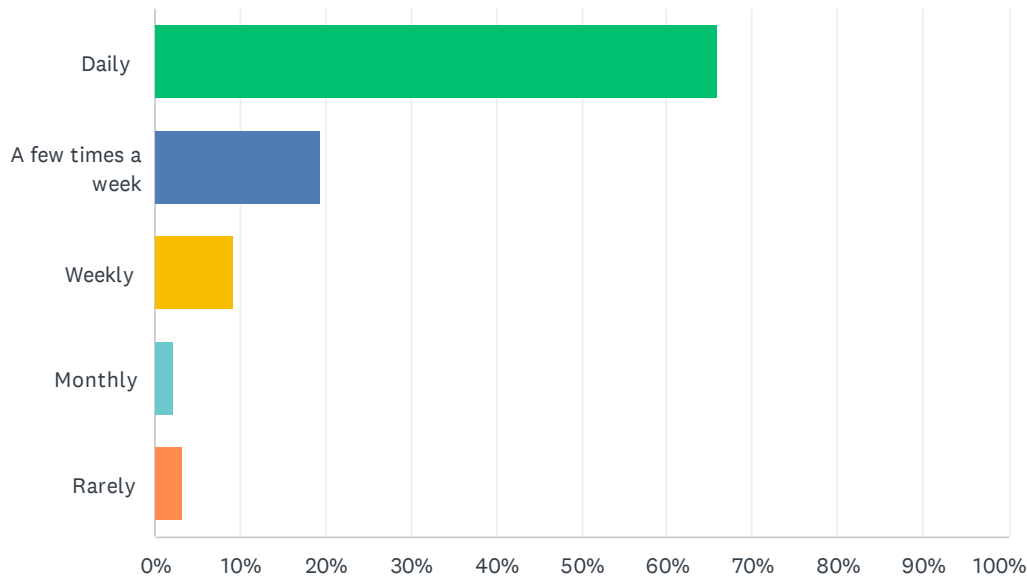

Q8 How often do you travel on rural roads in the KIRPC region?

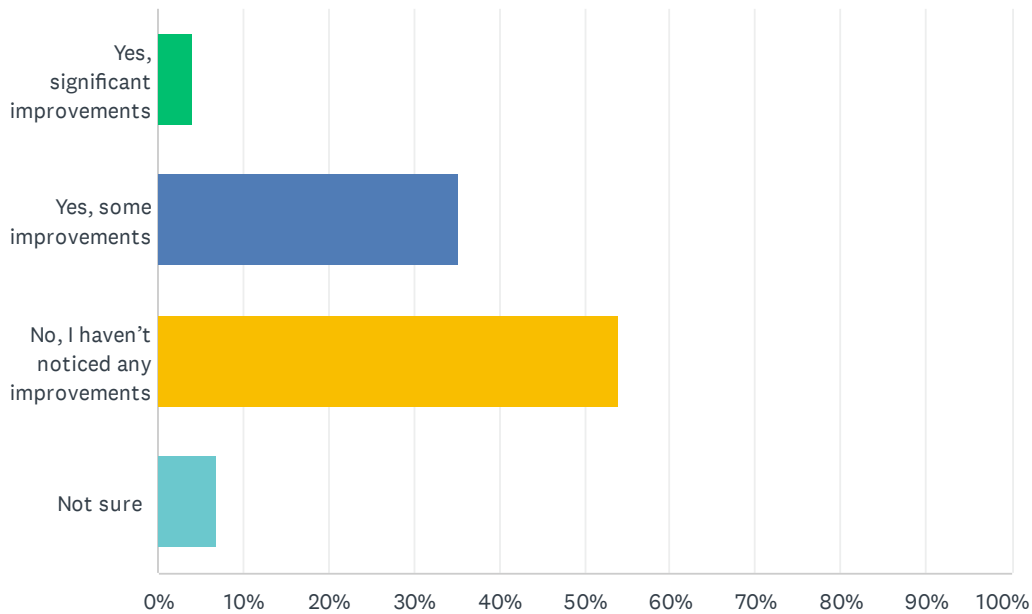

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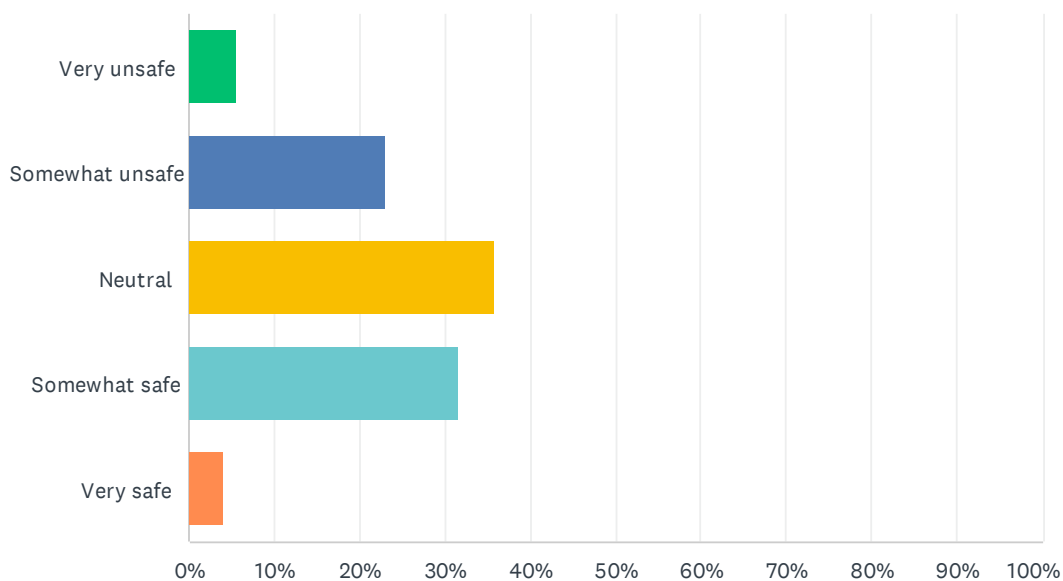

Q11 How would you rate the overall safety of rural roads in your county?

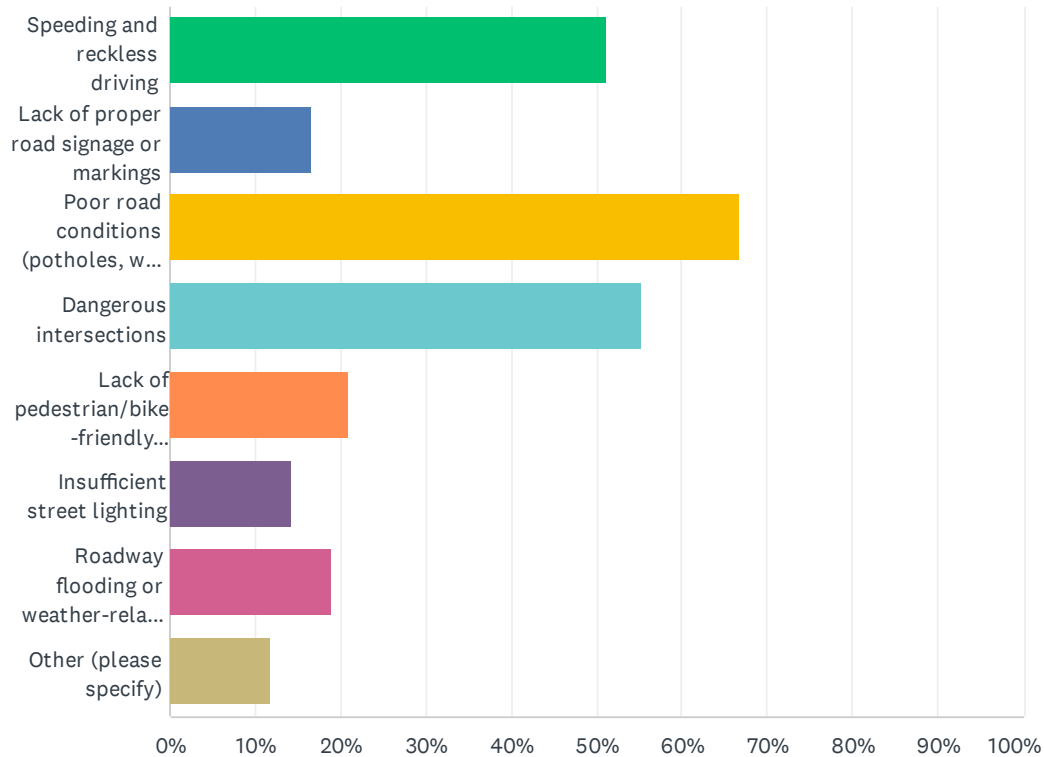

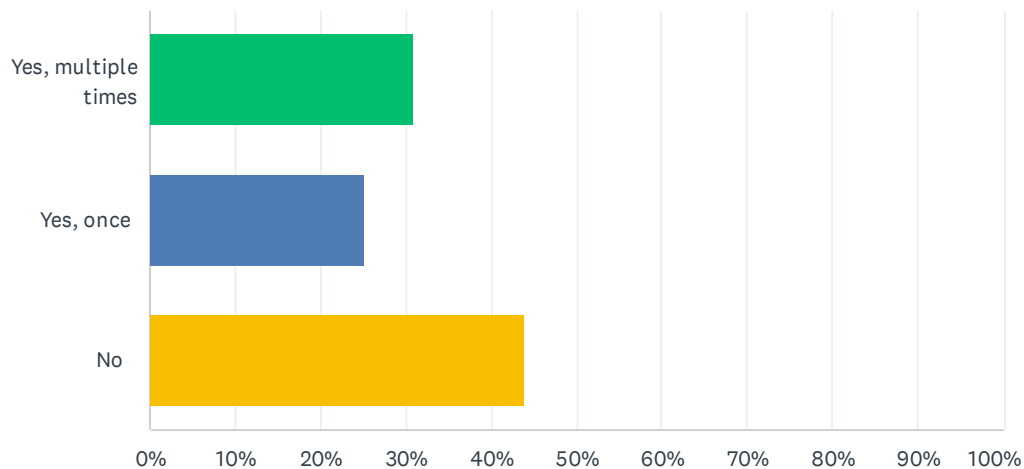

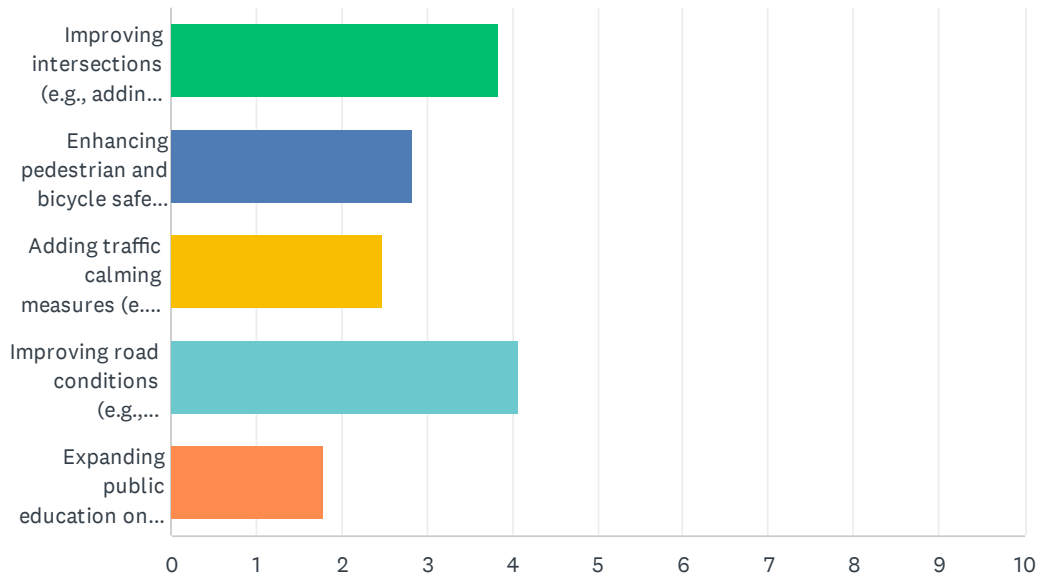

Q14 What safety improvements do you think should be prioritized in the Safety Action Plan? (Please rank the following from highest priority to lowest priority)

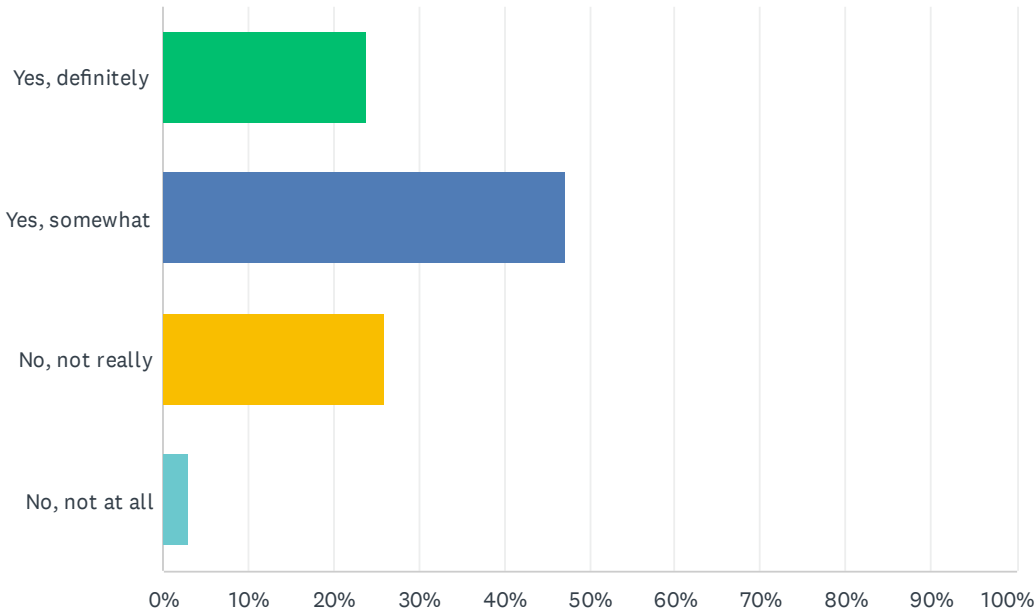

Q15 Do you believe a Safety Action Plan would improve safety on rural roads in your area?

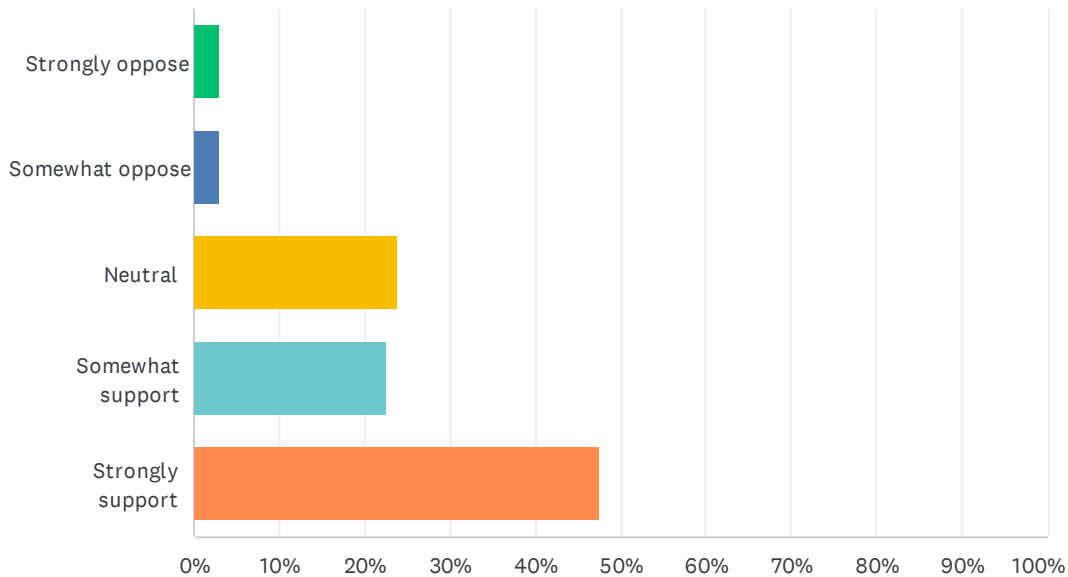

Q16 How supportive are you of using federal funding (through grants) to improve road safety in your county?

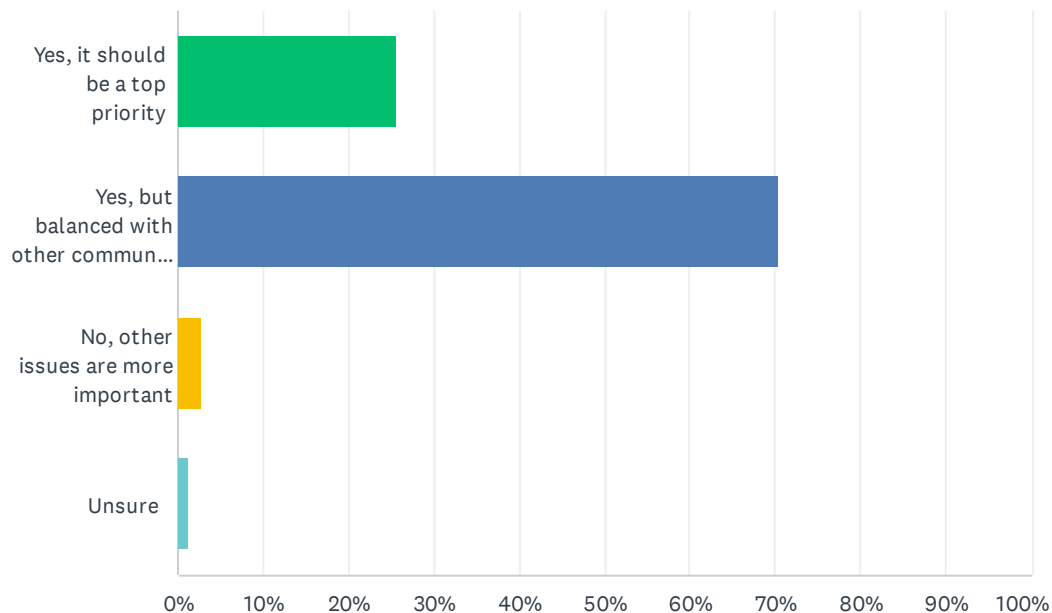

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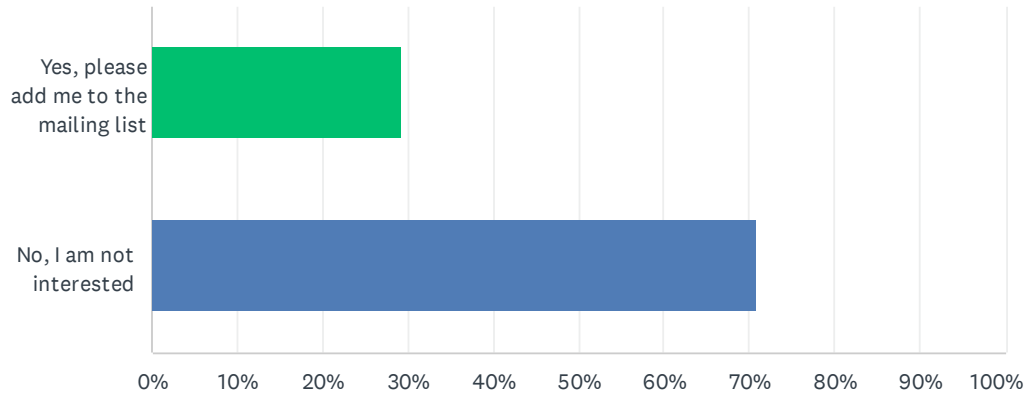
